3. Follow all instructions provided by the Range Safety Officer and remember he/she has the final word when it comes to safety at the launch site.
4. Follow US Forest Service rules for using the launch sites.
5. Know and follow all the NCR procedures for handling, prepping, launching, and recovering your rockets (see the [Launch Procedures](#) web page).
6. Take only pictures from the launch site and leave only footprints (and possibly that rocket that disappeared over the horizon). In other words, don't leave trash behind.
7. Familiarize yourself with the fire fighting procedures and equipment. Be prepared to help fight fire in the event that one starts burning.
